Week 10: March 3-9 ~ 2 Nephi 20-25

Sunday/FHE - Song recommendation: I Believe in Christ. **Print this week's activity found at the end of the lesson plan in the CFM manual. Print the "banner" attached to this lesson plan. You can print one for the family to design together or one for each member.** While coloring the week's activity, read 2 Nephi 21:6-9. **What do those verses teach about what can happen when everyone follows the Savior? How can we make our home more like this? Read verses 6-7 again. Which of these would you want as a pet in next life? Read 2 Nephi 21:11-12. Isaiah said that the Lord would set up an "en sign for the nations" to help gather to Him. An ensign is like a flag. Let's design our own flag(s) the would represent why we come to Jesus and His Church. How could your banner help gather God's people? We don't have banners we hang nowadays but what do we do and/or say that lets others know what we believe and who we follow?**

Monday - Do the section, "Jesus Christ will judge in righteousness" in the CFM manual. See pictures below the banners at the end of this lesson plan for reference if needed.

Tuesday - Listen to, "The Peace of Christ Abolishes Enmity" by Dale G. Renlund. **Lehi's children had a problem with contention. The problem got worse in future generations, leading to division, captivity, sorrow, and destruction. And contention continues to be a problem today. What can you do to be a peacemaker?**

Wednesday - Read and discuss the section "The worldliness of Babylon will fall" in the CFM manual.

Thursday - Read the first 2 paragraphs of the section "We talk of Christ, we rejoice in Christ" in the CFM manual. Watch "Jesus Heals a Man Born Blind" and "Suffer the Little Children" and point out joyful moments. **Why do you "rejoice in Christ"?**

Friday - Listen to "We Talk of Christ" by Elder Neil L. Andersen. **Elder Neil L. Andersen suggests how we can speak more openly of Christ in various settings. Which of his suggestions stood out to you? What opportunities do you have to talk of Christ with others?**
