Week 15: April 6-12 ~ Doctrine & Covenants 30-36

Sunday/FHE - song: I'll Go Where You Want Me to Go

Elder Gary E. Stevenson taught that proclaiming the gospel "can be accomplished through simple, easily understandable principles taught to each of us from childhood: love, share, and invite" Watch "Inviting All to Come unto Christ: Sharing the Gospel" Whether you have a formal calling as a missionary or are proclaiming the gospel like the young men in the video, you can be witness of Jesus Christ "at all times, and in all things, and in all places." Lets keep a record this week of things the Lord asks of us and then the promises the Lord makes as we share the gospel. Draw a line down the center of one page and on one side write: "What The Lord Asks of Me" and on the other side write: "Blessings I Receive When I Share the Gospel" We'll start filling in the chart by reading the following scriptures: Doctrine & Covenants 30:8; 31:3-5; 32:1, 5; 35:13-15, 24.

Monday - Read the intro for the week in the CFM manual. Read "The Fatih and Fall of Thomas Marsh" discussing as you go if needed. Read Doctrine & Covenants 31: 1-2, 5-6, 9, 13. What guidance and promises did the Lord give to Thomas B. Marsh about his family? How can His words help us in our family relationships? Fill out the chart you started yesterday if anything new has come up.

Tuesday - Read the section "Parley and Thankful Pratt" and "Sidney and Phebe Rigdon" in Voices of the Restoration: Early Converts What evidence do you see that the Lord's hand was in the lives of these early Church members? Who has the Lord placed in your life to help you come to Christ? How is He preparing you to bless others through your faithfulness, love, or invitation?

Wednesday - Take turns reading "Ezra Thayer: From Skeptic to Believer" discuss as you go how you can avoid being pulled away from the church

Thursday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 33:12-18 and Helaman 5:12. How can we ensure we are firmly built upon the rock? Make sure to add to your chart we started on Sunday!

Friday - As we sing the song "Families Can Be Together Forever" we are going to write down the names of all of our family members including extended family such as aunts, uncles, cousins, grandparents, etc. Sing the song at speed WHILE also writing down family names. Why was it difficult to do both tasks at once? Read Doctrine & Covenants 30:1-2. What are some things of the earth that can distract us from

remembering Jesus Christ and His gospel? How can we keep our focus on Him? If there is time, you may want to [print a copy of the activity](#) and play the game with the younger children.
