Week 24: June 8-14 ~ Doctrine & Covenants 60-63

Sunday/FHE - song: I Want to Be a Missionary Now

Read the intro for this week in the CFM manual. Read Doctrine & Covenants 60 & 62.

How is your testimony of the gospel like a "talent," or a treasure from God? In what ways do we sometimes "hide [our] talent"? What encouraging messages did you hear in those sections? Does that help build your confidence in sharing the gospel? What are some ways you can share the gospel?

Monday - As He instructed His missionaries, the Lord revealed important truths about Himself. What do we learn about Him from these verses? Read Doctrine & Covenants 60:2-4; 61:1-2, 20, 36-38; 62:1, 6.

Tuesday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 61:22, 24. The first verse we read says, "it mattereth not..." and the section verse we read stated, "...this is the way...". Why do you think He sometimes leaves decisions up to us and other times He makes it clear there is a right and wrong way to go? Why is it good for us to make some decisions without expecting God to tell us exactly what to do?

Wednesday - Read and discuss the section "Signs come by faith and the will of God," in the CFM manual.

Thursday - This lesson is for older children. I will be having the discussion with our 12 year old and up. Watch "Standards: Sexual Purity and Modesty—True Confidence" What did you learn in that video brings TRUE confidence? [the Spirit] When we are comparing ourselves to the world and looking for the world's approval you will NEVER feel like enough. When you choose to prioritize to live as He would have us and dress, speak, and make choices that align with that, you will have the Spirit with you and as you are consistent with those choices you will find your confidence grow because you feel good about the choices YOU made because YOU wanted to....not because its what you thought others would do.

Friday - Read and discuss the section "Sacred things should be treated with reverence," in the CFM manual and then play this week's activity.
