Week 39: September 21-28 ~ Doctrine & Covenants 106-108

Sunday/FHE - song:

Read Doctrine & Covenants 106 & 108. The Lord gave counsel and promises to two members who were called to serve in His Church. How have you been asked to serve in His Church? [ministering assignments, class presidency, calling, sustaining others in their callings, service, missionary work...] What do you feel is the Lord's message to YOU in these sections? Is there a phrase that stuck out to you in either section?

Monday - Listen to "Serve" by Elder Carl B. Cook and encourage the kids to take notes as they do. How can we draw strength from the experiences of our ancestors? [we must read/hear about them and learn from their experiences] What can you do now to help your posterity learn from you long after you are gone? [journal with intention]

Tuesday - Read the intro for the week in the CFM manual. Read Doctrine & Covenants 107:1-4, 18-20. Read and discuss the section "The priesthood is 'after the Order of the Son of God'" in the CFM manual. .

Wednesday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 107:22. What do you think it means to uphold the Lord's servants by your confidence? by your faith? by your prayer? [believe the best of others. help them rise to the occasion. give them confidence by showing them you believe in them. sustain them in their callings. pray for your leaders, especially ones you may struggle with or disagree with]

Thursday - As we read today, let's regularly ask, "What do I learn about the Savior?" It's important to remember that no matter what we are reading or learning about in the scriptures, they all point to Jesus Christ and how we can become more like Him. Read Doctrine & Covenants 107:23-24, 33-35, 38. What did we learn about the 12 Apostles there? [they are a special witness, equal in power & authority to the general presidency, they oversee the 70, they are traveling council that preaches and administers the gospel] What do we learn about the Savior? [He loves us and wants us to succeed so He puts a lot of plans in place to assure that] In verses 60-66 we learn the order of Deacons, Teachers, Priests, Elders, and High Priests. Read verses 91-92. There we just read about His senior Apostle, the President of the Church. How is he "like unto Moses"? Use footnotes if needed to help you find the answer. [He leads us just as Moses lead the children of Israel] Read verses 99-100. What is your duty in the church? How can we ensure we are not becoming slothful but are being

diligent in all He asks of us? [live intentionally! always be looking for ways to serve and show grace and patience with others. be willing to go the extra mile]

Friday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 107:27-31, 85-89. What makes a council effective? Why is important to have these gatherings and check-ins? Lets listen to a talk that will help us learn how to apply this to family councils. Listen to "Family Councils" and discuss what you learn and how you can apply it in your family.
