Come Follow Me - Doctrine & Covenants 2025 Week 41: October 5-11 ~ Doctrine & Covenants 111-114

Sunday/FHE - song: watch "I Feel My Savior's Love"
Read Doctrine & Covenant 111. Joseph Smith and others worried about the debts the Church had accumulated in doing the Lord's work. What did the Lord say to Joseph in that section that could also bring you comfort with the things you worry about? What does the phrase "as fast as ye are able to receive them" teach you about Heavenly Father? How can the song we watched help us when we are feeling worried or stressed?

Monday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 112 and discuss anything that sticks out to you as you go.

Tuesday - In reading the section yesterday we read about Lord's words to Thomas B Marsh to help with his hurt feelings. One of the things that he was reminded of was to be humble. Why do you think humility is so important? [we can learn when we are humble, we are more open to promptings, we are happier because we aren't prideful and holier than thou mentatlity] What do you think it means for the Lord to lead you "by the hand"? [He'll help you every step of the way if we stay in contact with Him and allow Him to]. Read the section "Pattern of Humility" in the message "Patterns of Discipleship" by Elder Joseph W. Sitati. (note that this is also linked below for extra reading. the whole message is a great one for personal study!)

Wednesday - You need something to blindfold a child for this discussion. Blindfold a child and then put chairs and other obstacles in their way. Ask them to make it to the other side of the room and tell them they can ask for help at any time. Lead them around the obstacle when asked to step in. Are you able to make it through the obstacle on your own? How much easier was it when you asked for help? How much pain and bruises did it save you to have help? In life, the Lord and our loving Heavenly Father want to help us through the obstacles, but we have to ask for help. What can we learn about humility from this lesson/activity? [things are easier, and less painful, when we accept we can't do it on our own and ask for help] In this experiment you can make it through the obstacle without help you may just be a little banged up and bruised. In life, we cannot make it to the celestial kingdom without our Savior and His Atonement. Staying humble reminds us that we NEED Him and why not have Him with us as much as possible to make things easier? Watch "In Humiliity Our Savior"

Thursday - Read and discuss the section "Those who are truly converted come to know Jesus Christ" in the CFM manual. Watch "Chapter 41: Trouble in Kirtland: 1837-1838" and relate to the section you just read in the manual.

Friday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 113 and then the section "Joseph Smith was a 'servant in the hands of Christ" in the CFM manual.
