Come Follow Me - Doctrine & Covenants 2025 Week 5: January 26-February 1 ~ Doctrine & Covenants 3-5

Sunday/FHE - Song recommendation: watch "<u>Be Thou My Vision</u>" by Elenyi Read the intro for this week in the CFM manual and then read and discuss the section "I can trust God," stopping after reading and discussing the bullet points.

Monday - Elder Lynn G. Robbins gives many scriptural examples in this talk "Which Way Do You Face?" Where people feared God, and some examples of people who gave in to pressure from others. Lets listen to the talk and then we'll discuss. You may want to ask them following the talk about any thoughts they have, any experiences they may have had where they were faced with pressure to do something but chose to follow God instead, or help prep them with the choices they can make now that will leave them well equipped and ready when they are faced with pressure from the outside world.

Tuesday - Read the first two paragraphs of the section "I can serve God with all my heart, might, mind, and strength" in the CFM manual. Read Doctrine & Covenants 4 and then return to the manual to read the last two paragraphs of the section and discuss.

Wednesday - Watch "Chapter 4: Martin Harris and the Lost Pages: 1827-1828" Have there been times when you have been tempted to do something that you know isn't right? How can we set ourselves up for success to stay obedient to the Lord and not give into temptations to go against His will? [Be aware of His plan for starters by asking Him, think about long term consequences for choices you are making, pray for strength to stay true to what you know, surround yourselves with true friends who would never put you in the situation and will instead always support your beliefs, morals, and values]

Thursday - Read and discuss the section "Through the Holy Ghost, I can gain a witness of the Book of Mormon" in the CFM manual. Make sure to read the verses associated with the bullet points.

Friday - Read 2 Nephi 3:6-24 and Doctrine & Covenants 5:1-10. What do these verses teach us about Joseph Smith's role in our day—and in our life? (This pulled directly from a section in the CFM manual but I'm saving having to refer to the book/app)
