## Come Follow Me - Doctrine & Covenants 2025 Week 7: February 9-15 ~ Doctrine & Covenants 10-11

Sunday/FHE - Song recommendation: "Let the Holy Spirit Guide"

Satan would prefer that we forget he exists—or that we at least fail to recognize his attempts to influence us, but the Lord's words in Doctrine & Covenants 10 confirm that Satan is real—and he actively opposes the work of the Lord. Read verses 1-33. What did God know about Satan's efforts? How can God help us resist Satan's efforts? Read verses 34-52. Nephi didn't know why he was inspired to make two sets of records for his people. And Mormon didn't know why he was inspired to include the second set with the gold plates. But both prophets trusted that God had "a wise purpose." Today we know at least part of that purpose: to replace the 116 lost pages of the Book of Mormon. What do you think the Lord wants you to learn from all of this? What impresses you about the Lord's wisdom and foresight in preparing for the loss of the 116 pages? (Today's discussion is compiled from parts of the first two sections in the CFM manual)


Monday - Listen to "By Divine Design" by Ronald A. Rasband and discuss. Have you noticed evidence of His wisdom and foresight in your life? How has the Lord been working in your life? What "coincidences" has He prepared? What foundations has He laid for your blessings? Encourage them to journal any promptings they have or thoughts that come to mind during this time/discussion.

Tuesday - Finish reading Doctrine & Covenants 10 by reading verses 53-70 and discuss any prompting you get as you go.

Wednesday - Today we'll read Doctrine & Covenants 11 and tomorrow and Friday we'll dissect the chapter and discuss it further. Read the whole section.

Thursday - Read Doctrine & Covenants 11:1-4. What do we need to be a good missionary? [A desire to serve Him and others(v.3) & action in doing what is asked(v.4)] What can you do while waiting to serve a mission? Read verses 16-22 [study and gain your own knowledge, build your testimony, keep the commandments, cleave unto Him, "obtain" His word, holds our peace, study the scriptures, learn to serve others and be a peacemaker] Why do you think it's important to gain your own testimony first? [you will be able to speak with more conviction, you will be able to better recognize promptings, the Spirit will be stronger when you teach, trusting in His plan always pays off]

Friday - One thing Hyrum was told in section 11 was that he could seek revelation for himself and not just rely on Joseph receiving it for him. Although we can all receive personal revelation, it can be hard to not doubt ourselves and our ability to do so. We may find ourselves doubting whether what we felt was the Spirit or our own thoughts. Today we'll discuss how we can tell if our thoughts are our own or the Spirit. Read Moroni 7:16; I will also use the sticker pictured below as guidance in the discussion. "How can I know when I have received a revelation and not just a thought of my own?" is also a great place to turn to for guidance. Encourage them to write notes in their journal for reference in the future.
